Consultation on North Island West Coast Finfish Plan

The Ministry of Fisheries has been working with tangata whenua and stakeholders to develop a number of Fisheries Plans. These plans identify the value different stakeholders obtain from the fishery, set objectives for the fishery to get best value, design the management of the fishery to achieve the objectives and make fisheries management more transparent.

Please find enclosed a copy of the summary of the draft Fisheries Plan for North Island West Coast Finfish. The plan has been developed by an advisory group comprising tangata whenua, commercial, recreational stakeholder representatives, and MFish. This plan will eventually make up a chapter of a more encompassing Inshore Fisheries Plan that will be developed in future years.

The Minister is considering whether to approve, under section 11A of the Fisheries Act 1996, the plan's objectives and general strategies¹. MFish is now consulting on the plan on behalf of the Minister of Fisheries.
